

An important update for Members, Guests and Visitors of West Tradies.

We are all aware of the Coronavirus and we at West Tradies, are committed to protecting the health, safety & wellbeing of our patrons and team members.

Your Club will continue to actively monitor the number of approved persons permitted to enter the premises and all developments in relation to Coronavirus.

A range of measures have been implemented to ensure the safety & wellbeing of our patrons & team members. These measures include, but not limited to:

- The placement of additional hand sanitisers throughout the venue.
- Increased signage regarding good hygiene practices.
- Regularly updating our team members on good hygiene practices and COVID-19 developments.
- Increasing the frequency of our cleaning practices, such as frequent sanitisation of 'high touch areas' including bathrooms, door handles and buttons.
- Removal of cutlery, straws, seasoning and condiments for public access.
- Review of promotions and events.
- Encouraging 'social distancing' per authority advice.
- Wearing of gloves in food preparation areas.

In addition, all persons who have returned from overseas from midnight Monday 16 March 2020, or been in contact with people who have returned from overseas travel are required by law to self-isolate for a period of 14 days and as a result will not be permitted to enter the Club premises.

Our team members will be discouraged from engaging in personal contact, such as the shaking of hands with fellow staff, members, guests and visitors. Please do not take this in any other way than as a preventative and control measure to help prevent the spread of viruses.

Your Club will continue to monitor the advice of NSW Health and implement advice accordingly.

We ask for your understanding and cooperation as we continue our commitment to offering a quality-based community hub for all people of our community to enjoy.
